1. Why Game Saves Disappear

Hard drives fail, SSDs corrupt, cloud syncs overwrite each other, and uninstalling a game can wipe your local saves. If you've ever lost a 100-hour save file, you know the pain. A proper backup system prevents this.

2. The 3-2-1 Backup Rule for Gamers

Keep 3 copies of your saves, on 2 different types of storage, with 1 copy off-site. Local copy on your PC, backup copy on an external drive or NAS, and a copy synced to cloud storage. GoodSync automates all three.

3. Know Where Your Games Save Files

Every game puts saves in a different place ? some in Documents, some in AppData, some in the game folder itself. GoodSync's folder sync finds and monitors specific folders so you never miss one.

4. Real-Time vs Scheduled Backups

Real-time sync writes every change as it happens (no lag, no data loss). Scheduled sync runs every hour or day (less writing, good for SSDs). GoodSync does both. Set it once and forget about it.

5. Version History Saves You From Yourself

Accidentally overwrote a good save with a bad one? Version history keeps previous copies. You can roll back to any version from the last 30 days. That accidental overwrite is instantly fixable.
