## 1. Stop Using the Same Password for Everything

When you reuse passwords across your gaming accounts, one breach compromises everything. That Destiny account you made in 2017? If it got leaked, someone has your email and password for every other service you use.

## 2. A Password Manager Is Not Optional

You cannot remember 50+ unique passwords. Period. A password manager like RoboForm creates, stores, and autofills strong passwords for every account. You only need to remember one master password.

## 3. Strong Passwords Are Easy With a Generator

Good password: "j8!Kx@mP4#zL9\$qR" ? 16 characters, random, impossible to guess. Bad password: "Gamer4Life2021" ? cracked in seconds. A password manager generates the good one and fills it in so you never type it.

## 4. Enable Two-Factor Authentication Everywhere

A password alone isn't enough anymore. Two-factor adds a second check (a code from an app or text) that stops hackers even if they have your password. Most gaming platforms support it ? turn it on in your account settings.

## 5. Audit Your Old Accounts

You probably have 50-100 old gaming accounts you barely use. Each one is a risk. RoboForm can run a security audit that flags weak, reused, or compromised passwords so you know exactly which ones to fix.
